NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a **GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION** will be held in the City of Tracy on **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026**, for the following Elected Officials:

One (1) Mayor	Full Term of Two Years
One (1) City Council Member Representing District 1	Full Term of Four Years
One (1) City Council Member Representing District 3	Full Term of Four Years

THE NOMINATION PERIOD FOR THESE ELECTED OFFICES BEGINS ON MONDAY, JULY 13, 2026, AT 8:00 A.M. AND CLOSSES ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 7, 2026, AT 5:00 P.M. ALTHOUGH CITY HALL WILL BE CLOSED ON AUGUST 7, 2026, THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE WILL BE OPEN FROM 8:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M. TO COMPLETE THE NOMINATION PERIOD.

If nomination papers for an incumbent Officer of the City are not filed by Friday, August 7, 2026, at 5:00 p.m., the voters shall have until Wednesday, August 12, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. to nominate candidates other than the persons who are the incumbents for that incumbent's elective office.

Filing papers may be obtained by appointment only during regular business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. every other Friday, beginning on Monday, July 13, 2026, at the City Clerk's Office, 333 Civic Center Plaza, Second Floor, Tracy, California 95376. **On July 24, 2026, City Hall and the City Clerk's Office will be closed due to the building's regular business schedule. The City Clerk's Office will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2026, to complete the nomination period.** For further information, please call (209) 831-6105 or visit the City's website at <https://www.cityoftracy.org/Departments/City-Clerks-Office/Elections/2026-Election-Information>.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by California Elections Code Section 10229.

The vote center locations and hours of operations, ballot drop box locations and hours of operations, vote-by-mail procedures and timing, the election officers, and all other persons and procedures for the General Municipal Election shall be the same as those utilized by the County of San Joaquin and in compliance with the California Elections Code. On election day, the polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
