THE POSITION:

Under the direction of the Pool Manager and Recreation Coordinator, Lifeguards play a vital role in creating a safe, fun, and welcoming environment for all pool patrons. From monitoring pool activities and enforcing safety rules to performing rescues, providing first aid/CPR, and teaching swim skills, this role is ideal for individuals who are dependable, team-oriented, and passionate about public safety and recreation.

If you're ready to build valuable life-saving skills, gain hands-on experience, and enjoy a flexible schedule—including evenings, weekends, and holidays—this is your chance to dive into a rewarding role with the City of Tracy! 

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

Following is a general list of duties for this position. These duties include, but are not limited to:

- ◆ Guard the pool and surrounding area.
- ◆ Perform swimming rescues and first aid.
- ◆ Assist in the training of volunteers and students.
- ◆ Enforce City, department, and program rules, policies, and regulations.
- ◆ Maintain a safe environment in the pool and surrounding area and ensure safety of pool patrons.
- ◆ Remain present at the pool during work shift.
- ◆ Assist other City staff and members of the public.
- ◆ Attend staff meetings and trainings.
- ◆ Prepare and maintain reports and records.
- ◆ Work a flexible work schedule that may include evenings, holidays, and weekends.
- ◆ Provide swimming instruction to persons of all ages and abilities.
- ◆ Maintain professional, courteous behavior toward co-workers, members of the public and all others contacted in the course of work.
- ◆ Perform duties assigned by supervisor.



WORK SCHEDULE:

This is a temporary PART-TIME position. The successful candidate would be required to work variable hours. Hours can vary from 5 to 35 hours per week. Incumbents may be required to work weekends, evenings, and holidays.

Appointment will be contingent upon the ability to provide proof of eligibility to work in the United States and the results of a pre-employment physical examination, which will include drug, alcohol, and TB screening.
